- 3. Update and Adoption of the Agenda; no additions to the Agenda. MSP
- 4. Approval of October 2022 Minutes. MSP
- 5. Review of Committee Meeting Days/Times/Host
  - Next meeting: March 13, 11:00 am 12:30 pm
  - Following meeting: Monday, May 8, 11:00 am 12:30 pm
- 6. Summer Reading Incentives/Update Numbers
  - Each year SERRA coordinates with museums and food sponsors for all SERRA libraries (examples: The Nat, San Diego Automotive Museum, etc.)
  - Committee members will use the SERRA Google Drive account to update numbers for 2023
  - Username/password will be sent to SERRA Youth Services committee members
- 7. San Diego Museum Month 2023
  - Meeting with San Diego Museum Council in late December 2022 regarding San Diego Museum Month, which is February 2023

- SERRA libraries will partner with San Diego Museum Council and provide passes for patrons
- Both a virtual and print option for passes will be provided
- First 5 San Diego may be an additional partner
- 8. Professional Development Workshop 2022 Discussion
  - Over 90% of attendees rated the workshop as "Good" or "Excellent"
  - 80% of attendees were "Extremely Satisfied" or "Very Satisfied" with the keynote speakers
  - There is a lot of survey data that can be used for next year's planning
  - Favorite breakout sessions were:
    - Neurodiversity 101
    - Diversifying Collections
    - o Intellectual Freedom
  - Suggestions for topics next year include: EDI, 3D printers, early childhood education, parent-inclusive programming, collection development, outreach storytimes, mental health, popular books
  - The next workshop is tentatively October 19, 2023 and spaces have been reserved at San Diego Public Library's Central location

#### 9. Roundtable

- Carlsbad City Library: Children's services hosted an event with staff from all three locations to create system-wide storytime standards.
- Chula Vista Public Library:
  - Construction is still happening
  - o The library hosted a great holiday program with Santa
  - A local ballet company put on a free version of the Nutcracker
  - Staffing issues have been a challenge

#### Oceanside:

- Winter Reading Challenge runs December 1 January 31
- Considering doing Beanstack Bingo Challenge for Spring Reading
- o New programs including music and movement
- o Four new teen interns will begin soon
- Dungeons & Dragons program going well
- o Toy collection put on the floor instead of behind the staff desk
- The number one concern families have with toys is sanitizing, which staff do before they are checked out.
- San Diego County Library:
  - Getting a One Book, One San Diego report ready for KPBS because their reports are due to their partners at the end of January
  - New Lakeside library does not have an opening date but it is coming soon
  - Started ordering for Summer Learning and Día giveaway books
  - Attended a Mental Health and Youth Leadership Academy hosted by San Diego Pride
  - Working to get new vendors available for bookings

#### Coronado:

- Winter Reading Challenge theme: "Snow Better Time to Read"
- Preparing for National Puzzle Day with a program in the library
- San Diego Public Library:
  - o Participating in the Winter Reading Challenge
  - Hosting a Performers' Showcase on March 16
  - Finalizing Spring into Steam 2023 challenge, "Dig In" (archaeology, paleontology)
  - Library Card Contest launches in April
  - Formalizing a literacy and programming equity working group
  - Writing contest had 27 participants system wide; writing contest will be moved to Summer instead of Fall
  - New programmings: "Dancing Feet" dance program, "Family Flicks" movie program
  - o Holiday party in December at Central library had 70 attendees
  - Sensory program with snow was held
  - Looking to introduce a bilingual storytime at Central
- Escondido Public Library:
  - Escondido-based Aztec dance group di a program in October
  - Holiday program with Santa drew 140 attendees
  - o Preparing for upcoming programs like Star Wars month
  - Working with Cal State San Marcos
