- 5. Budget Status report FY20/21 Carol Dinuzzo
 The Budget Status Report for Fiscal Year 20/21 reflects the reconciled bank statements
 through October 31, 2020. PLSEP awards included with increases of project revenue at
 \$92,507. PLSEP Indirect and Support Staff revenue increased by \$18,197 and \$17,651,
 respectively. Expenditures currently fall within the projected cost for the fiscal year.
- 6. SCLC Shared eResource Sharing

 Committee invited to make suggestions on how to expend CLSA 19/20 funds, given that library operations have changed since original ideas were collected in May 2018.

 Suggestions included conducting a new survey, consortial spending, seeking input from Technology committee, and investing in human efforts to support new technologies. Bednarski also suggested pursuing collaborative grants from the State Library.
- 7. Biennial Review Conflict of Interest Code Diane Bednarski Committee members asked to review the current code. No changes requested.
- 8. Office Lease Diane Bednarski Review of current office lease contract, and office space requirements for FY21/22. Committee agreed to move item onto Administrative Council, for approval.
