- 7. Summer Reading Incentives/Update Numbers

- Incentives from Mendocino Farms will determine which libraries get the incentives
- Francesca has been in contact with Automotive Museum and will follow up with Natural History Museum regarding passes for SERRA libraries.
- Traditionally libraries print the passes using the logos from the museums.
- Worth asking In-N-Out for support.
- San Diego Public Library has had Yogurt Land and Panda Express in the past.
- For reading incentives, we ask that there is no purchase necessary or barring entry so as to be equitable in access.
- Reading incentive numbers reviewed for 2023.
- 8. San Diego Museum Month 2023
  - On the whole, passes were well-distributed at SERRA libraries.
  - Dan will provide distribution numbers to Museum Council.
  - Amy noted that many patrons used the digital pass after Oceanside ran out of print copies of the pass.

- Short staffing

### Coronado

- In midst of Coronado Community Read, *Project Hail Mary*
- Space-themed programming to go with Community Read
- Gearing up for flower show that takes place annually
- Have had busy storytimes lately

### Oceanside

- Short staffed as well
- Lunch at the Library grant received, got more funds than requested
- Doing STEAM camps during the summer, a local farm will run a camp (grant funded)
- Ukulele classes via Uke Can Do It grant, have been doing staff classes for use storytimes and other events
- Testing out Bingo on Beanstack with Spring Reading Challenge

### Carlsbad

- Gearing up for Carlsbad Reads Together, youth selection is *Bright Star* by Yuyi Morales
- Doing a staff-only reading challenge to test Bingo on Beanstack before using for Summer Reading Adventure

San Diego County Library

- Lakeside Library's grand opening is March 25, but it has had a soft opening and is open now
- National History Day just finished up, year-long history competition sort of like a science fair, SDCL sponsors a research award and staff help as judges
- San Diego's National History Day winners will go on to state competitions, and state winners will go to national competitions
- Dia events are being planned, books are being ordered for Dia and Summer Learning
- Will have story trails at 20 different parts throughout the County
- Solar eclipse is coming up in mid-April and will have glasses to provide to the public
- Some branches will host a NASA bus, coordinating with Facilities team
- Have started planning for Pride, SDCL and SDPL will be at the same booth at the Pride festival, planning for Lit Café

San Diego Public Library

- Planning a Ramadan storytime
- Getting ready for Lunch at the Library, asked for \$180,000 and received the whole amount, will be used for enrichment activities and staffing, four locations
- Putting together a program for families called "Kidchella," which will be an afternoon of music for families with other activities like face painting
- Will be launching story strolls around sustainability in May
- Pride library card contest will be launching April 1, using iRead theme of "Find Your Voice"
- Hosting Inclusive Prom at the Central Library, ages 14-19

### Escondido

- Doing a Dia program in April
- In May doing second annual Star Wars week with an entire week of programming
- Working with San Diego Air & Space Museum to do a preschool storytime, grant that is for the museum to come out and do a program at libraries
